2022 Construction Detours

Two RAIN route sections are different this year due to roadway construction projects requiring alternative routing. Signage and roadway markings will be in place to clearly mark this year's route.

- 1. A bridge over I-70 on Old SR 267 (Center Street) south of Plainfield is closed for repairs. The RAIN route will use county roads west of Old SR 267 to bypass this construction. Rest Stop 2 at Plainfield Middle School will still be open, with the rest stop being accessed by a short loop east from Sugar Grove Road.
- 2. A five-mile section of US 40 through Knightstown east to SR 3 at Dunreith is also under construction. The RAIN route will first take a short bypass of this construction using Jackson Street, one block south of US 40. After the RAIN route rejoins US 40 briefly to cross Big Blue River, single-lane traffic on US 40 east of Knightstown to SR 3 at Dunreith will be bypassed using Old National Road south of US 40. Old National Road bypasses the "big" US 40 hill east of Knightstown but, of course, has its own hill to climb out of the Blue River valley.

Construction barrels are in place on the roadway shoulder from Dunreith east 4 miles to Lewisville, but both east-bound travel lanes are open with clear sailing to Richmond.
